## MARIAN

### T-SHIRT

*Striped raglan t-shirt w/sleeve top*

*Knitting skill level: \*\*\* Medium*

*Instruction: Åsa Christiansen*

#### Sizes:

(XS) S (M) L (XL) 2XL (3XL)

#### Measurements:

Bust: (90) 94 (102) 108 (116) 126 (132) cm

Length: approx (53) 54 (55) 56 (57) 58 (59) cm

Sleeve length: 8 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

#### Yarn:

LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 % linen, 50 g = 110 m)

#### Yarn required:

Almond white #3011: (4) 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 (7) balls

Blue-gray #6061: (2) 2 (2) 2 (2) 2 (3) balls

#### Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3.5 mm and 4 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

#### Tension:

20 sts St-st with 4 mm ndls = 10 cm

#### Pattern:

Work 6 rnds St-st with almond white, change to blue-gray and work 1 rnd St-st and 1 rnd ribbing (k1, p1).

Rep these 8 rnds.

#### Back and front:

With almond white and 3.5 mm circular ndl cast on (180) 188 (204) 216 (232) 252 (264) sts. Join and work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds

Insert marker at each side with (90) 94 (102) 108 (116) 126 (132) sts for each part.

Change to 4 mm circular ndl and cont **pattern** until garment meas approx (33) 33 (33) 34 (34) 34 (34) cm.

Cast off 8 sts at each side for armholes (= 4 sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

#### Sleeves:

With almond white and 3.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (58) 60 (62) 64 (66) 68 (70) sts. Join and work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Insert marker between first and last st on rnd.

Change to 4 mm double pointed ndls and cont **pattern** until sleeve meas approx 8 cm, or suitable length. End with the same pattern rnd as back/front.

Cast off 8 middle underarm sts (= 4 sts at each side of marker).

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

#### Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 4 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (264) 276 (296) 312 (332) 356 (372) sts.

Insert marker at each junction. Work 2 rnds **pattern**.

Cont **pattern**, and **at the same time** dec for raglan as follows: k2tog after each marker, and k2tog tbl before each marker = 8 sts dec.

Rep raglan dec on alt rnds (9) 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (15) times = (192) 196 (208) 216 (228) 244 (252) sts.

Cont raglan dec 10 times over sleeve sts **only** = (152) 156 (168) 176 (188) 204 (212) sts.

Armhole meas approx (15) 16 (17) 17 (18) 19 (20) cm.

Cast off rem 12 sleeve sts at each side, and transfer the (20) 22 (22) 24 (24) 26 (26) middle front sts for neck to spare ndl. Work each side separately.

#### Edge st: k every row.

#### Back:

= (64) 66 (72) 76 (82) 90 (94) sts.

Work 8 rows **pattern** back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side (= approx 3 cm).

Cont with almond white and shape shoulder as follows: Cast off at beg of every row 4 sts (2) 1 (0) 0 (0) 0 (0) times, 5 sts (1) 2 (2) 1 (0) 0 (0) times, 6 sts (0) 0 (1) 2 (2) 0 (0) times, 7 sts (0) 0 (0) 0 (1) 2 (0) times, 8 sts (0) 0 (0) 0 (0) 1 (3) times. Transfer rem (38) 38 (40) 42 (44) 46 (46) sts for neck to spare ndl.

Garment meas approx (53) 54 (55) 56 (57) 58 (59) cm.

#### Left front:

= (22) 22 (25) 26 (29) 32 (34) sts.

Work 8 rows **pattern** back and forth, **at the same time** dec for neck on alt rows 4 sts once all sizes, 3 sts (1) 0 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) time, 2 sts (0) 1 (0) 0 (1) 1 (1) time, 1 st (2) 2 (2) 2 (1) 1 (1) time.

Shape and cast off at shoulder in the same manner as the back.

#### Right front:

= (22) 22 (25) 26 (29) 32 (34) sts.

Work in the same manner but in a mirror image of left front.

#### Finishing:

Sew shoulder seams to a nice and even line.

Fold the cast off sts on sleeve, and sew 6 of the sts to the front and 6 of the sts to the back.

#### Neckband:

With almond white and small 3.5 mm circular ndl knit up at neck edge 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row to approx (84) 88 (92) 96 (100) 102 (104) sts. Number of sts a multiple of 2.

Work 7 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.

Sew underarm openings.
