CHAMOMILE
T-SHIRT*Oversize blouse w/raglan**Knitting skill level: *** Medium**Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland***Sizes:**

(XS) S (M) L (XL) 2XL (3XL)

Measurements:

Bust: (107) 111 (116) 120 (124) 129 (133) cm

Length: approx (54) 55 (56) 58 (59) 61 (62) cm

Sleeve length, underarm: 12 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

TYNN LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 % linen, 50 g = 220 m)

Yarn required:

Dusty pastel blue #7521: (4) 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 (7) balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

INFO: Work blouse from hem up.

Sleeves are worked separately and joined to the same ndl as back and front.

Work yoke back and forth with slit at middle front and dec for raglan.

Work slit edgings and collar at finishing.

Edge st: k every row**Back and front:**

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (288) 300 (312) 324 (336) 348 (360) sts. Join and work 5 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Insert marker at sides with (144) 150 (156) 162 (168) 174 (180) sts for each part.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl and cont St-st in rnds until garment meas (26) 26 (27) 28

(29) 30 (30) cm.

Cast off (20) 22 (24) 26 (28) 30 (32) sts at each side for armholes (= (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 15 (16) sts at each side of markers), and **at the same time** cast off 10 middle front sts for slit.

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (136) 140 (144) 148 (152) 156 (160) sts. Join and work 1½ cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Insert marker at beg of rnd = middle underarm.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl and cont St-st in rnds 12 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off (20) 22 (24) 26 (28) 30 (32) underarm sts for armhole (= (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 15 (16) sts at each side of marker). Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

Raglan:

Row begin at middle front.

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off, **at the same time** cast on 1 new st at beg and end of row = edge sts, and k2tog at each junction = 4 markers for raglan dec = (468) 480 (492) 504 (516) 528 (540) sts.

Next row: Work p over all sts inside 1 edge st at each side.

Insert marker around each of the 4 sts for raglan, and dec for raglan as follows:

Work until 1 st before marked st, sl 2 k-wise (as working k2tog), k1 and psso = 8 sts dec.

NOTE: The rem sts after dec are the new marked sts for raglan.

Rep dec on alt rows (28) 29 (30) 31 (32) 33 (34) times = (244) 248 (252) 256 (260) 264 (268) sts.

Next row: P all sts inside edge sts.

Work raglan dec further (10) 10 (10) 10 (10) 11 (11) times more, **at the same time** cast off for neck at beg of every row 6 sts (0) 0 (0) 1 (1) 1 (1) time, 5 sts (1) 1 (1) 0 (0) 0 (0) time, 3 sts once for all sizes, 2 sts (3) 4 (4) 4 (5) 4 (4) times, 1 st (5) 4 (4) 4 (3) 5 (5) times = (19) 20 (20) 21 (22) 22 (22) sts cast-off for neck at each side.

Cast off rem (126) 128 (132) 134 (136) 132 (136) sts.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

Slit bands:

With 2.5 mm ndls knit up sts inside 1 edge st at one side of slit, approx 1 st in every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row until approx (45) 47 (49) 51 (51) 53 (55) sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work approx 3½ cm ribbing back and forth as follows:

(First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Cast off rib-wise a little loosely.

Work the same at other side.

Collar:

With 2.5 mm ndls knit up 10 sts at slit bands on each side, and knit up at neck edge 1 st every st/row side, but miss approx every 4th st/row until approx (145) 147 (149) 153 (155) 155 (157) sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work approx 10 cm ribbing back and forth as follows:

(First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

For an elastic edge use a thicker needle or work Italian cast off.

Place slit bands, right over left, and sew bands nicely with hidden sts to bottom of slit.
