



NO 7 LAVENDER CARDIGAN

Cardigan w/v-neck, raglan and eyelet

pattern

Knitting skill level: *** Medium

Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(XS-S) M (L-XL) 2XL-3XL

Measurements:

Bust: (92) 107 (122) 137 cm

Length: approx (48) 50 (52) 54 cm

Sleeve length: approx 47 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

MANDARIN PETIT (100 % cotton,
50 g = 180 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN
MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

Yarn required:

Almond white #3011: (5) 7 (9) 11 balls

Notions:

Options: Buttons or one clasp

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

24 sts x 36 rows/rnds diagram with 3 mm
ndls = 10 x 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

Back and front:

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (217) 253 (289) 325 sts, and work ribbing back and forth in this manner:

Row 1: (= WS) 1 edge st, p2 tbl, *k1, p2 tbl*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Row 2: 1 edge st, k2 tbl, *p1, k2 tbl*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Rep row 1- 2 until ribbing meas 2 cm, work last row from WS.

Insert marker around 1 st at each side with (54) 63 (72) 81 sts for each front, and (107) 125 (143) 161 sts for the back.

Sizes XS-S:

Work diagram **A** inside 1 edge st at each side until garment meas 29 cm.

End with a full diagram, **at the same time** on last row cast off 17 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + 8 sts at each side).

Sizes M (L-XL) 2XL-3XL:

Work diagram **A** inside 1 edge st at each side until garment meas 25 (21) 17 cm, end with a full diagram

From RS dec for v-neck in this manner:

Work 1 edge st, k1, sl 1, k1, psso, work diagram until 4 sts rem, k2tog, k1, 1 edge st.

Rep dec every 4th row (3) 6 (9) times = 247 (277) 307 sts.

Work 3 rows diagram **A**, **at the same time** on last row cast off 17 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + 8 sts at each side).

NOTE: Work St-st when not enough sts for working (1 yo and k2tog).

All sizes:

Put aside and work sleeves

Sleeves:

With (3) 2½ (3) 2½ mm double pointed ndls cast on (54) 63 (54) 63 sts. Join and work 2 cm ribbing (p1, k2 tbl) in rnds.

Sizes M og 2XL-3XL:

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls

All sizes:

Insert marker around first st on rnd.

Work diagram **B** and when sleeve meas 6 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Cont diagram **B** and rep inc approx every (2) 2 (1½) ½ cm until (90) 99 (108) 117 sts on rnd.

Work new sts in pattern as they arise.

Cont until sleeve meas approx 47 cm, or suitable length.

End with the same pattern rnd as back/front, and cast off 17 middle underarm sts (= marked st + 8 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (329) 377 (425) 473 sts.

Insert marker around 2 k sts at each junction.

Cont **diagram**, and on next row dec for v-neck and raglan as follows:

Work 1 edge st, k1, sl 1, k1, psso, *work diagram until **2 sts before** marker, k2tog, work marked sts, sl 1, k1, psso*, rep from *-* until 4 sts rem, k2tog, k1, 1 edge st.

Rep dec for raglan on alt rows a total of (29) 33 (37) 41 times and dec for v-neck every 4th row a total of (14) 16 (18) 20 times.

INFO: In total (14) 19 (24) 29 times of v-neck dec are worked, including previous v-neck dec on back and front.

NOTE: Work St-st when not enough sts for working (1 yo and k2tog).

Leave rem sts on ndl for neck.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

Front/neck edging:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row at right front edge, knit sts at neck, and knit up sts in the same manner on left front edge to approx (328) 337 (346) 355 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 3+1.

Work 2 cm ribbing back and forth as for back/front.

Optional: Work buttonholes on right front band.

Cast off rib-wise.

Optional: Sew buttons or clasp on.
