PUFF SWEATER

BOOKLET 1914, NO. 5 / SWEATER W/PUFF SLEEVES / INSTRUCTION: LIV STANGELAND



SIZES (XS) S (M) L (XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (89) 96 (101) 110 (120) cm Length: (53) 53 (54) 56 (58) cm Sleeve length: 38 cm, all sizes All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

YARN

BØRSTET ALPAKKA (96 % alpaca, 4 % nylon, 50 g = 110 m)

YARN REQUIRED

Dk.sky blue #6042: (7) 7 (8) 8 (9) balls

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 4 mm and 5 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

TENSION

16 sts St-st with 5 mm ndls = 10 cm

EDGE ST: K EVERY ROW

BACK AND FRONT

With 4 mm circular ndl cast on (142) 154 (162) 176 (192) sts. Join and work 5 cm ribbing k1 tbl, p1 in rnds.

Insert marker at sides with (71) 77 (81) 88 (96) sts for each part.

Change to 5 mm circular ndl, and cont St-st until garment meas (33) 33 (33) 35 (36) cm. Cast off 6 sts at each side for armholes (= 3 sts at each side of markers), and work each side separately.

BACK

= (65) 71 (75) 82 (90) sts.

Cont St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side, <u>at the same time</u> cast off for armhole at beg of every row at each side 3 sts (0)0(0)0(1) time, 2 sts (1)1(1)2(2) times, 1 st (9)12(13)14(14 times = (43) 43 (45) 46 (48) sts.

Cont until back meas (53) 53 (54) 56 (58) cm. Cast off in this manner: Cast off <u>firmly</u> the 7 first and the 7 last sts (pull sts tog) for shoulder. Cast off rem neck sts suitable firm.

FRONT

= (65) 71 (75) 82 (90) sts.

Work and cast off for armhole as the back, at the same time when front meas (43) 43 (43) 45 (46) cm cast off the (11) 11 (13) 14 (16) middle front sts for neck and work each side separately.

Cont cast off at neck on alt rows 2 sts twice, 1 st 5 times.

Cont until front meas (53) 53 (54) 56 (58) cm. Cast off <u>firmly</u> rem 7 sts.

Work other side the same but in a mirror image.

SLEEVES

With 4 mm double pointed ndls cast on (28) 28 (32) 32 (34) sts and work 12 cm ribbing k1 tbl, p1 in rnds.

K 1 rnd St-st, inc evenly spaced to (84) 84 (88) 88 (88) sts. (Inc: in every st work in front and back of loop and pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st between (28) 28 (24) 24 (20) sts.

Insert marker at beg of rnd.

Change to 5 mm double pointed ndls and cont St-st until sleeve meas 23 cm. Cast off 2 sts at center underarm (= k2tog before and after marker). Rep cast off every 1½ cm 3 times more = (76) 76 (80) 80 (80) sts. Cont until sleeve meas 38 cm, or suitable length. Cast off 6 middle underarm sts.

SLEEVE CAP

= (70) 70 (74) 74 (74) sts.

Cont St-st back and forth, at the same time cast off at beg of every row at each side 1 st 10 times = (50) 50 (54) 54 (54) sts. Cont until sleeve cap meas (12) 12 (13) 13 (14) cm.
Cast off at beg of every row at each side 7 sts 3 times

Cast off rem (8) 8 (12) 12 (12) sts. Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams to form narrow shoulders.

With sewing ndl baste yarn at upper edge of sleeve cap, pull yarn to gather for puff sleeve. Adjust width of sleeve to fit armhole Neckband:

With 5 mm ndl cast on (80) 80 (82) 82 (84) sts. Change to 4 mm double pointed ndls and work 12 cm ribbing in rnds, k1 tbl, p1. Change to 5 mm ndl and cast off loosely rib-wise

Sew neckband nicely to neck. Fold double and sew loosely on WS with hidden sts.
