SILJA CARDIGAN

Cardigan w/raglan, worked from neck down

Instruction: Liv Inger Espedal

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (68) 68 (79) 79 (90) 90 cm

Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm, or suitable length

Sleeve length: (24) 26 (31) 34 (38) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

Yarn:

MERINOULL (100 % merino wool,
50 g = 105 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, SMART, ALPAKKA, DUO, MANDARIN MEDI, SPOT

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Corn yellow #2015: (6) 7 (8) 8 (9) 10 balls

Notions:

(6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 buttons

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 mm and 3.5 mm

2.5 mm crochet hook

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

22 sts pattern with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

Beg at neck.

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (83) 83 (107) 107 (107) 107 sts and work 3 rows ribbing back and forth as follows: (first row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1,

p1*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Change to 3.5 mm circular and work ribbing with buttonholes as follows:

Left front band boy:

1 edge st, k1, 1 yo, k2tog, p1 (= front band sts), k1, *p5, k1*, rep from *-* until 5 sts rem, end with p1, k1, p1, k1, 1 edge st.

Right front band girl:

1 edge st, k1, p1, k1, p1 (= front band sts), k1, *p5, k1*, rep from *-* until 5 sts rem, end with p1, k1, 1 yo, k2tog, 1 edge st.

Insert marker on 4 k sts = marked sts for raglan inc as follows:

Insert marker on (18th.) 18th (24th) 24th (24th) 24th and (30th) 30th. (36th.) 36th (36th) 36th st from each side = (17) 17 (23) 23 (23) 23 sts for each front, 11 sts for each sleeve and (23) 23 (35) 35 (35) 35 sts for the back.

Cont in this order and work extra height at beck of garment with «german short rows» to avoid holes as follows:

Cont in this order and work extra height at beck of garment with «german short rows» to avoid holes as follows:

Work (50) 50 (68) 68 (68) 68 sts, turn, sl first st to right ndl with yarn in front of work, tighten yarn firmly at the back, and there are now 2 loops on right ndl, work (16) 16 (28) 28 (28) 28 sts, turn by sliding first st over over to right ndl with yarn in front of work, tighten yarn firmly at the back, and there are now 2 loops on right ndl. Turn one more time at each side by working 2 sts passed previous turning, work loops tog. Cont to end of row after last turning and work 1 row from WS.

Raglan inc on RS rows: 1 yo at each side of each marked st = 8 sts inc.

Work k on k sts, p on p sts, and k all yo from WS


NOTE:

For the 5 front band sts at each side skip every 8th and 9th row, and turn work before these sts at each side. Rep buttonholes approx every (6) 6,5 (6,5) 7 (6,5) 6,5 cm.

Work **diagram** back and forth inside 5 front band sts at each side, and inc for raglan as shown in diagram a total of (20) 21 (22) 23 (24) 25 times, and on last row cast off the 4 marked sts = (239) 247 (279) 287 (295) 303 sts on row =(37) 38 (45) 46 (47) 48 sts for each front, (63) 65 (79) 81 (83) 85 sts for the back and (51) 53 (55) 57 (59) 61 sts for each sleeve.

- k on RS, p on WS
- p on RS, k on WS
- 1 yo
- k2tog
- k2togtbl
- p2tog
- sl 1 k-wise, k2tog, pss0

Back and front:



Cont with 3,5 mm circular ndl and work sts for front, cast on (9) 7 (5) 3 (13) 11 new underarm sts, work sts for the back, cast on (9) 7 (5) 3 (13) 11 new underarm sts, work sts for front = (155) 155 (179) 179 (203) 203 sts.

Work **diagram** back and forth until garment meas (34) 38 (42) 46 (48) 50 cm from shoulder, or 2 cm before suitable length.

Change to 3 mm circular.

Work 2 cm ribbing k1, p1 inside 1 edge st at each side.

Cast off rib-wise.

Sleeves:

Transfer sleeve sts to 3,5 mm double pointed ndls and pick up 1 st in each underarm st at back and front = (60) 60 (60) 60 (72) 72 sts.

Rnd beg at center underarm.

Work **diagram** in rnds until sleeve meas (22) 24 (29) 32 (36) 38 cm, meas at underarm, or until 2 cm before suitable length.

Change to 3 mm double pointed, k 1 rnd, **while** dec evenly spaced to (36) 38 (40) 42 (44) 46 sts.

Work 2 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Work other sleeve the same.

Finishng:

Sew buttons on.
