WILLOW CARDIGAN

Cardigan w/structural pattern and raglan

Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (64) 68 (72) 76 (80) 86

Width at hem: (81) 85 (91) 96 (103) 109 cm

Length: approx (38) 42 (46) 50 (52) 54 cm

Sleeve length: (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

Yarn:

TYNN ALPAKKA ULL (65 % alpaca, 35 % wool, 50 g = 166 m)

Alternative yarn:

TOVE

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

White #1002: (3) 4 (5) 6 (7) 8 balls

Notions:

(5) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 buttons

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

26 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm Diagram meas approx 8 cm

Edge st: k every row

Back and front:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (207) 217 (235) 247 (265) 281 sts and work 3 cm ribbing back and forth as follows: (first row = WS) 1 edge st,

p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Last row of ribbing on RS.

Change to 3 mm circular and p 1 row from WS.

Next row: 1 edge st, (12) 12 (14) 14 (16) 16 sts St-st, insert marker, work diagram, (57) 62 (67) 73 (78) 86 sts St-st, insert marker, (25) 25 (29) 29 (33) 33 sts St-st, insert marker, (57) 62 (67) 73 (78) 86 sts St-st, diagram, insert marker, (12) 12 (14) 14 (16) 16 sts St-st, 1 edge st.

Cont in this order until garment meas approx (10) 13 (14) 16 (16) 17 cm.

Cont St-st and **diagram** as before and dec on next row as follows:

Work until 2 sts before first marker, k2tog, work until second marker, sl1, k1, psso, work until 2 sts before third marker, k2tog, work until 4th marker, sl 1, k1, psso = 4 sts dec.

Rep dec every 4th row (11) 11 (13) 13 (15) 15 times = (163) 173 (183) 195 (205) 221 sts.

Cont until work meas approx (24) 27 (30) 33 (34) 35 cm.

From RS cast off for armholes as follows:

Work (36) 38 (41) 44 (46) 50 sts, cast off 8 sts, work (75) 81 (85) 91 (97) 105 sts, cast off 8 sts, work to end of row.

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (40) 42 (44) 46 (48) 50 sts. Join and work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 3 mm double pointed. Insert marker on first and last st of rnd.

Cont St-st and when sleeve meas 5 cm inc 1 st at each side of marked sts.

Rep inc approx every 2 cm until (60) 64 (68) 72 (76) 80 sts on rnd.

Cont until sleeve meas (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 40 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 8 center underarm sts (= marked sts + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

Raglan:

Work sleeve sts on the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off, **at the same time** p2tog at each junction, and insert marker on each of these 4 sts = (247) 265 (283) 303 (321) 345 sts

Cont St-st and **diagram** as before and dec for raglan on RS rows as follows: Work until 1 st before marker at each junction, sl 2 sts (as working k2tog), k1, psso = 8 sts dec.


Rep dec on alt rows (16) 17 (18) 20 (21) 23 times.

NOTE: When raglan dec meet diagram on fronts cont dec on sts for sleeves and sts for the back as follows:

Work until marker between front and sleeve, sl 1, k1, psso, dec for raglan as before at markers between each sleeve and the back, work until 1 st before marker between sleeve and front, k2tog.

Cast off the first 6 sts at each side for neck.

Cont to cast off 3 sts at beg of every row, at the same time cont raglan dec as before where possible (5) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 times more, and (21) 22 (24) 26 (28) 30 times of dec on the back are finished.



□ k on RS, p on WS
☑ p on RS, k on WS
□ p3, transfer these sts back to left ndl, lead yarn in front of work and transfer sts back to right ndl. Rep this once more. Yarn has now been twirled around the 3 sts twice.
□ p5, transfer these sts back to left ndl, lead yarn in front of work and transfer sts back to right ndl. Rep this once more. Yarn has now been twirled around the 5 sts twice.



Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

Left front band for girl/right for boy: With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row until approx (93) 101 (109) 117 (125) 133 sts on row.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 2 cm ribbing back and forth as for back and front.

Right front band for girl/left for boy: Work in the same manner as other side, but with (5) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 buttonholes evenly spaced after approx 1 cm.

The lower approx 2 cm from cast on row, the upper at neckband. This is done later.

Buttonhole: k2tog, 1 yo

Neckband:

Transfer sts at neck to 2.5 mm circular ndl, and at the same time knit up sts at neck edge to approx (101) 105 (109) 113 (117) 121 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 2 cm ribbing back and forth as for back and front.

Remember last buttonhole.

Cast off rib-wise.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings. Sew buttons on.





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
