PEPLUM SWEATER

Raglan sweater w/flounce Instruction: Åsa Christiansen

Sizes:

(XS) S (M) L (XL) XXL

Measurements:

Bust: (88) 93 (100) 108 (116) 126 cm Length: approx (56) 57 (58) 59 (60) 61 cm

Sleeve length: 47 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

ALPAKKA SILKE (70 % baby alpaca, 30 % Mulberry silk, 50 g = 200 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT, TYNN ALPAKKA ULL, SISU Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Burnt golden brown #2544: (6) 6 (7) 8 (8) 9 balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Back and front:

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (476) 504 (540) 584 (628) 680 sts. Join and work 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Next rnd: work k2tog in the rnd = (238) 252 (270) 292 (314) 340 sts. Insert marker at each side with (119) 126 (135) 146 (157) 170 sts for each part

Cont St-st until work meas 38 cm. Cast off for armholes (10) 10 (10) 12 (12) 14 sts at each side (= (5) 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 sts at each side of markers). Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (56) 58 (60) 62 (64) 66 sts. Join and work 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls cont St-st, **while** inc evenly spaced (22) 24 (28) 30 (34) 38 sts on first rnd = (78) 82 (88) 92 (98) 104 sts.

Insert marker between first and last st of rnd and cont St-st until sleeve meas 47 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off (10) 10 (10) 12 (12) 14 middle underarm sts.

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (354) 376 (406) 428 (462) 492 sts.

Insert marker at each junction. Rnd beg on the back, at right side junction. Dec for raglan at each marker as follows: k2tog after each marker, and k2tog tbl before each marker = 8 sts dec.

Rep raglan dec on alt rnds a total of (18) 20 (22) 24 (26) 28 times = (210) 216 (230) 236 (254) 268 sts.

Cast off for neck the (17) 20 (23) 26 (27) 30 middle front sts.

Cut yarn and beg again at neck working back and forth. Dec for raglan on RS rows, **at the same time** cast off 2 sts at beg of every row at each side for neck, and cast off for raglan on alt rows over sleeve sts <u>only</u> as follows: *work until first marker, k2tog, work until 2 sts before next marker, k2tog tbl*, rep from *-* over sts for the other sleeve. Rep a total of 7 times = (137) 140 (151) 154 (171) 182 sts.

Rep in the same manner, but cast off only 1 st at beg of every row 7 times more = (95) 98 (109) 112 (129) 140 sts.

Cast off.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

Neckband:

With small 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up at neck edge approx 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row = (132) 136 (140) 144 (148) 152 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2.

Work 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.





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
