# MOSS CARDIGAN

Cardigan w/round yoke worked from neck-down

Instruction: Liv Stangeland

Sizes:

(XS-S) M (L-XL)

## Measurements:

Bust: (98) 111 (125) cm Length: (52) 54 (56) cm Width overarm: (31) 35 (38) cm

Sleeve length: 47 cm, or suitable

length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

### Yarn:

KOS (62 % baby alpaca, 9 % wool, 29 % nylon, 50 g = 150 m)
TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

# Yarn required:

**KOS** 

White #1012: (5) 5 (6) balls TYNN SILK MOHAIR Natural #1012: (3) 4 (5) balls

Notions:

5 buttons

## Suggested knitting needles:

Circular 5 mm, 6 mm and 7 mm

Double pointed 6 mm and 7 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

### Tension:

13 sts St-st with double yarn (1 strand KOS + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR) and 7 mm ndls = 10 cm

13 sts and 20 rows pattern with double yarn and 6 mm ndls =  $10 \times 10$  cm

### Inc 1

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st

## Rib-stitch (rib-st):

K1 in stitch on previous row

# Rib-pattern:

**Row 1:** 1 edge st, 1 rib-st, \*p1,

1 rib-st\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st

**Row 2:** 1 edge st, p1, \*k1, p1\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st. Rep row 1 - 2.

Edge st: k every row

#### Yoke:

With 5 mm circular ndl cast on (55) 63 (71) sts, and work 3 cm ribbing back and forth as follows: (first row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, \*k1, p1\*, rep from \*-\* end with 1 edge st.

Change to 6 mm circular ndl.

Work 3 rows rib-pattern.

From WS inc as follows on next row: 1 edge st, \*p1, inc 1, k1\*, rep from \*-\*, end with p1, 1 edge st = (81) 93 (105) sts.

Work back and forth and work sts as they appear in **rib-pattern** until garment meas (7)  $7\frac{1}{2}$  (8) cm.

Next row from WS: Inc as follows:

1 edge st, \*p1, k2, inc 1\*, rep from \*-\* end with p1, 1 edge st = (107) 123 (139) sts.

Work sts as they appear in

**rib-pattern** until garment meas (11) 12 (13) cm.

Inc in the same manner, alternately at beg and end of St-st section (WS) approx. every (4)  $4\frac{1}{2}$  (5) cm (3) 3 (3) times more = (185) 213 (241) sts.

Cont until garment meas (26) 28 (30)

Divide work for sleeves, fronts and back as follows:

Work (28) 33 (37) sts (= front), transfer the next (35) 40 (45) sts for sleeve to spare ndl, cast on 5 new underarm sts, work (59) 67 (77) sts (= back), transfer the next (35) 40 (45) sts for sleeve to spare ndl, cast on 5 new underarm sts, work (28) 33 (37) sts (= front).

# **Back and fronts:**

= (125) 143 (161) sts.

Change to 7 mm circular ndl.

Cont St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side, until garment meas (46) 48 (50) cm meas from shoulder, or until 6 cm before suitable length.

Change to 6 mm circular ndl.

Work 6 cm ribbing back and forth as at beg of work.

Cast off rib-wise.

## Sleeves:

Transfer sleeve sts to 7 mm double pointed ndls, and knit up 1 st in each of the 5 new underarm sts = (40) 45 (50) sts.

Cont St-st in rnds until sleeve meas 41 cm, or 6 cm before suitable length. Work 1 rnd St-st and dec (16) 19 (22) sts evenly spaced = (24) 26 (28) sts. Change to 6 mm circular ndl, and work 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds Cast off rib-wise.

# Finishing:

# Left front band:

With 6 mm circular ndl knit up sts at front edge, 1 st every st, but miss approx every 4th st, to approx (89) 93 (97) sts on ndl.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 3 cm ribbing back and forth as at beg of cardigan.

Cast off rib-wise.

# Right front band:

Work in the same manner, but with 5 buttonholes evenly spaced after approx 1½ cm, the upper and lower 3 sts from edge.

<u>Buttonhole:</u> Cast off 1 st. Next row: cast on 1 st above the cast-off.

Sew buttons on.





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
