# RAINBOW SWEATER

1907 SUMMER KIDS, NO 6 / STRIPED SWEATER W/RAGLAN  
INSTRUCTION: ÅSA CHRISTIANSEN

## SIZES

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

## MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (64) 68 (72) 76 (82) 86 cm  
Length: (35) 40 (45) 50 (53) 55 cm  
Sleeve length: (23) 27 (31) 34 (38) 40 cm, or  
suitable length  
All measurements are for the finished  
garment = personal body measurements +  
movement allowance. The measurements  
are all according to given tension

## YARN

TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 %  
silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)  
TYNN LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 %  
linen, 50 g = 220 m)

## YARN REQUIRED

TYNN SILK MOHAIR  
Natural #1012: (2) 3 (3) 4 (4) 5 balls  
TYNN LINE  
Pastel blue #5930: (1) 1 (1) 1 (2) 2 balls  
Lilac #4612: 1 ball all sizes  
Yellow-green #2024: 1 ball all sizes  
Soft terracotta #3513: (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) 2 balls

## SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3.5 mm and 4 mm  
Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your  
knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker  
needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

## TENSION

20 sts St-st with double yarn and 4 mm ndls =  
10 cm

## WORK GARMENT WITH

1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR natural +  
1 strand TYNN LINE pastel blue/lilac/  
yellow-green/soft terracotta

## BACK AND FRONT

With 1 strand SILK MOHAIR natural and 1  
strand TYNN LINE pastel blue and 3.5 mm  
circular ndl cast on (140) 150 (158) 168 (180)  
190 sts. Join and work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in  
rnds.  
Change to 4 mm circular, k 1 rnd, while dec  
(12) 14 (14) 16 (16) 18 sts evenly spaced = (128)  
136 (144) 152 (164) 172 sts.

Insert marker at sides with (64) 68 (72) 76  
(82) 86 sts for each part.  
Cont St-st until garment meas (7) 8 (9) 9½  
(10½) 11 cm. Change to TYNN LINE lilac  
and cont until garment meas (14) 16 (18) 19  
(21) 22 cm. Change to TYNN LINE  
yellow-green and cont until garment meas  
(21) 24 (27) 28½ (31½) 33 cm.  
Change to TYNN LINE soft terracotta and  
cont until garment meas approx (23) 27 (31)  
35 (37) 38 cm  
Cast off (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 sts at each side for  
armholes (= (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 sts at each side of  
markers).  
Put garment aside and work sleeves.

## SLEEVES

With 1 strand SILK MOHAIR natural and 1  
strand TYNN LINE pastel blue and 3.5 mm  
double pointed ndls cast on (30) 32 (34) 36  
(38) 40 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 5 cm  
ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.  
Change to 4 mm double pointed, k 1 rnd,  
while inc (10) 12 (14) 16 (20) 22 sts evenly  
spaced = (40) 44 (48) 52 (58) 62 sts.  
Cont St-st until sleeve meas (7) 8 (9) 8½  
(11½) 13 cm. Change to TYNN LINE lilac  
and cont until sleeve meas (14) 16 (18) 18 (22)  
24 cm. Change to TYNN LINE yellow-  
green and cont until sleeve meas (21) 24 (27)  
27½ (32½) 35 cm.  
Change to TYNN LINE soft terracotta and  
cont until sleeve meas approx (23) 27 (31) 34  
(38) 40 cm  
Cast off (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 center underarm sts.  
Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

## ROUND YOKE

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 4 mm  
garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each  
armhole cast-off = (184) 200 (216) 224 (248)  
264 sts.  
Cont (2) 4 (6) 6 (8) 8 rnds St-st.  
Read following chapter before knitting:  
Dec as follows: \*k6, k2tog\*, rep from \*-\* in  
the rnd = (161) 175 (189) 196 (217) 231 sts.  
Work (6) 6 (6) 7 (7) 8 rnds without dec.  
Dec as follows: \*k5, k2tog\*, rep from \*-\* in  
the rnd = (138) 150 (162) 168 (186) 198 sts.  
Work (6) 6 (6) 7 (7) 8 rnds without dec.  
Rep dec in the same manner every (7th) 7th  
(7th) 8th (8th) 9th rnd with 1 st less between  
each dec on every dec rnd until (92) 100

(108) 112 (124) 132 sts rem, at the same time  
change to TYNN LINE pastel blue when  
work meas (28) 32 (36) 38 (42) 44 cm.  
Work (7) 7 (7) 8 (8) 9 rnds St-st, then dec as  
follows: \*k2, k2tog\*, rep from  
\*-\* in the rnd, and end with k(1) 1 (1) 2 (1) 1,  
and k(3) 3 (3) 2 (3) 3tog = (68) 74 (80) 84 (92)  
98 sts on rnd.

## NECKBAND

Change to 3.5 mm circular ndl and work 2 cm  
ribbing.  
Cast off suitably tight rib-wise.

## FINISHING

Sew underarm openings.
