PEPLUM SWEATER

Raglan sweater w/flounce Instruction: Åsa Christiansen

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (64) 68 (72) 78 (82) 85

Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm

Sleeve length: (26) 30 (33) 36 (39) 41 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

ALPAKKA SILKE (70 % baby alpaca, 30 % mulberry silk, 50 g = 200 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT, TYNN ALPAKKA ULL, SISU Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of

garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Warm brown #3543: (3) 4 (4) 5 (6) 7

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Back and front:

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (344) 368 (388) 420 (444) 460 sts. Join and work (5) 6 (6) 7 (7) 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Then work k2tog in the rnd = (172) 184 (194) 210 (222) 230 sts.

Insert marker at sides with (86) 92 (97) 105 (111) 115 sts for each part. Cont St-st until garment meas approx (23) 26 (29) 31 (32) 33 cm.

Cast off 8 sts at each side for armholes (= 4 sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (44) 46 (48) 50 (52) 54 sts. Join and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Insert marker around first and last st of rnd.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls and cont St-st.

Inc 1 st at each side when sleeve meas (5) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 cm.

Rep inc every (3) 3 (3) 3 (2 $\frac{1}{2}$) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ cm until (58) 62 (66) 70 (74) 78 sts on rnd.

Cont until sleeve meas (26) 30 (33) 36 (39) 41 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 8 middle underarm sts (= marked sts + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (256) 276 (294) 318 (338) 354 sts.

Insert marker at each junction.

Rnd beg by marker at right side on the back.

Cont St-st and dec for raglan as follows: k2tog after each marker, and k2tog tbl before each marker = 8 sts

Rep raglan dec on alt rnds (15) 16 (17) 18 (19) 20 times = (136) 148 (158) 174 (186) 194 sts.

Cast off the (14) 14 (15) 15 (15) 15 middle front sts for neck, cont to end of rnd, cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Cont back and forth and ensure to work raglan dec on RS.

Cont raglan dec, at the same time cast off for neck at beg of every row at each side 2 sts (3)3(2)3(3)2 times, 1 st (4)5(7)7(8)10 times (= (10) 11 (11) 13 (14) 14 sts cast off at each side of neck), and a total of (22) 24 (26) 28 (30) 32 raglan dec are finished (where possible).

Leave sts on ndl for neckband.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

Neckband:

Transfer neck sts to small 2.5 mm circular ndl and knit up approx 1 st every st/row, but skip every 4th st/row

to approx (80) 84 (88) 92 (96) 100 sts. Number of sts a multiple of 2.

Work (6) 6 (6) 7 (7) 7 cm ribbing as at beg of garment.

Cast off suitably loose.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (64) 68 (72) 78 (82) 85

Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm

Sleeve length: (26) 30 (33) 36 (39) 41 cm. or suitable length

Yarn:

Yarn required:

Warm brown #3543: (2) 2 (2) 3 (3) 4 halls

White #1002: (2) 2 (2) 3 (3) 3 balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Stripe pattern:

2 rnds white, 2 rnds warm brown, rep from *-*

Back and front:

With warm brown and 3 mm circular ndl cast on (344) 368 (388) 420 (444) 460 sts. Join and work (5) 6 (6) 7 (7) 8 cm ribbing and **stripe pattern** in rnds as follows:

Round 1: k all sts.

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Rep round 1 - 2, end with a white stripe. Always change color on **rnd 1**. Change to warm brown and work 1 rnd St-st.

Then work k2tog in the rnd = (172) 184 (194) 210 (222) 230 sts.

Insert marker at each side with (86) 92 (97) 105 (111) 115 sts for each part.

Cont **stripe pattern** in St-st until work meas approx (23) 26 (29) 31 (32) 33 cm.

Cast off 8 sts for armhole at each side (= 4 sts at each side of markers). Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With warm brown and 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (44) 46 (48) 50 (52) 54 sts. Join and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 cm **stripe pattern** and ribbing k1, p1 in rnds as at beg of garment. Insert marker around first and last st of rnd.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls, cont **stripe pattern** and St-st.

When sleeve meas (5) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Rep inc every (3) 3 (3) 3 (2½) 2½ cm until (58) 62 (66) 70 (74) 78 sts on rnd

Cont until sleeve meas (26) 30 (33) 36 (39) 41 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 8 middle underarm sts (= marked sts + 3 sts at each side of marker) on the same pattern rnd as back and front.

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (256) 276 (294) 318 (338) 354 sts.

Insert marker at each junction.

Rnd beg by a marker at right side of the back.

Cont **stripe pattern** and dec for raglan as follows: k2tog after each marker, and k2tog tbl before each marker = 8 sts dec.

Rep raglan dec on alt rnds (15) 16 (17) 18 (19) 20 times = (136) 148 (158) 174 (186) 194 sts on rnd.

Cast off the (14) 14 (15) 15 (15) 15 middle front sts. Work to end of rnd, cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Cont back and forth and dec for raglan on RS.

Cont raglan dec, at the same time cast off for neck at beg of every row at

each side \angle sis (3)3(2)3(3)2 times, is (4)5(7)7(8)10 times (= (10) 11 (11) 13 (14) 14 sts cast off at each side of neck), and a total of (22) 24 (26) 28 (30) 32 raglan dec are finished (where possible).

Leave sts on ndl for neckband.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings

Neckband:

Transfer neck sts to small 2.5 mm circular ndl and with warm brown knit up approx 1 st every st/row, but skip every 4th st/row to approx (80) 84 (88) 92 (96) 100 sts. Number of sts a multiple of 2.

Work 1 rnd St-st, then cont with (6) 6 (6) 7 (7) 7 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise suitable loose. Fold neckband to WS and sew with hidden sts.





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
