FAUNA
SWEATER*Worked from neck down**Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland***Sizes:**

(XS) S (M) L (XL) XXL (XXXL)

Measurements:

Bust: (105) 109 (114) 119 (124) 128 (133) cm

Length: approx (52) 52 (54) 54 (56) 56 (58) cm

Sleeve length: 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:SUNDAY (100% merino wool,
50 g = 235 m)TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair,
28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)**Yarn required:**

SUNDAY

Main color:

Lt.beige #3021: (4) 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 (7) balls

Pattern color 1:

Dk.brown #3072: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 2:

Dusty pastel green #8521: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 3:

Brown sugar #2543: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 4:

Straw yellow #2123: 1 ball all sizes

TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Main color:

Lt.beige #3021: (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) balls

Pattern color 1:

Golden brown #2755: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 2:

Dusty pastel green #8521: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 3:

Brown sugar #2543: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 4:

Straw yellow #2113: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular 4 mm

Small circular 3 mm for neckband

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

17 sts and 36 rows (= 18 ridges) with double yarn (1 strand of each type of yarn as listed) and 4 mm ndls = 10x10 cm

1 ridge = k 2 rows**Stripe pattern in ridges:**

Beg from RS and k 1 row with pattern color.

Work 2 rows from same side in this manner:

*p 1 row with main color,

p 1 row with pattern color,

k 1 row with main color,

k 1 row with pattern color*, rep from

- until a total of 8 stripes with pattern color, end with k 1 row with main color.

INFO:

Garment is worked with double yarn (1 strand SUNDAY + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR). Work back and front separately. Work a lower neckline at front and cast off for slanting shoulders.

Sew shoulder seams. Pick up sts for sleeves and work back and forth from top down.

Edge st: k every row**Front:**

With main color (double yarn) and 4 mm circular ndl cast on (91) 95 (99) 103 (107) 111 (115) sts and work (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 (10) cm ribbing as follows:

(First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* , end with 1 edge st.

Beg from RS and work 9 ridges = 18 rows main color.

Cont **stripe pattern** in pattern color 1.

Work 9 ridges main color.

Work **stripe pattern** in pattern color 2.

Work 9 ridges main color.

Work **stripe pattern** in pattern color 3.

Work 9 ridges main color.

Work **stripe pattern** in pattern color 4.

Change to main color and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (7) 7 (7) ridges.

Front meas now approx (46) 46 (48) 48 (50) 50 (52) cm, slightly stretched.

Cast off the (13) 13 (13) 15 (15) 15 (17) middle sts for neck and work each side separately.

Right side:

= (39) 41 (43) 44 (46) 48 (49) sts.

Cast off for neck on every row at neck side 4 sts once, 2 sts twice, 1 st twice = (29) 31 (33) 34 (36) 38 (39) sts.

Cast off for slanting shoulder in this manner: cast off at beg of every row at armhole side 5 sts (4)2(0)0(0)0(0) times, 6 sts (1)3(5)4(2)0(0) times, 7 sts (0)0(0)1(3)5(4) times, 8 sts (0)0(0)0(0)01 time **at the same time** cast off for neck 1 st 3 times.**Left side:**

= (39) 41 (43) 44 (46) 48 (49) sts.

Work in the same manner as right side.

Back:

With main color (double yarn) and 4 mm circular ndl cast on (91) 95 (99) 103 (107) 111 (115) sts and work in the same manner as front until garment meas approx (46) 46 (48) 48 (50) 50 (52) cm, slightly stretched.

Work 5 ridges with main color and end with the same row as front before cast off for slanting shoulders.

Cast off the (29) 29 (29) 31 (31) 31 (33) middle sts for neck and work each side separately.

Left side:

= (31) 33 (35) 36 (38) 40 (41) sts

Cast off at beg of every row at armhole side 5 sts (4)2(0)0(0)0(0) times, 6 sts (1)3(5)4(2)0(0) times, 7 sts (0)0(0)1(3)5(4) times, 8 sts (0)0(0)0(0)01 time, **at the same time** cast off at beg of every row at neck 2 sts twice, 1 st once.**Right side:**

= (31) 33 (35) 36 (38) 40 (41) sts

Work in the same manner as left side.

Sew shoulder seams inside 1 edge st at each side to a nice and even seam. Ensure seam is not too tight.

Left sleeve:

Measure (22) 23 (24) 24 (25) 25 (26) cm from outer point on shoulder seam and straight down with front slightly stretched. Insert marker here and the same on the back.

On RS beg at marker. With main color (double yarn) and 4 mm circular ndl pick up sts as follows:

Knit up 1 st every ridge (= every 2nd row) at front, 1 st at middle of shoulder and 1 st every ridge until marker on the back. K 1 row and **at**

the same time adjust number of sts to (73) 77 (81) 81 (85) 85 (89).

Work 5 ridges more in main color, **at the same time** on last row, k2tog inside 1 edge st at each side = 2 sts dec.

Work **stripe pattern** with pattern color 4.

Work 9 ridges in main color and rep dec on last row.

Work **stripe pattern** with pattern color 3.

Work 9 ridges in main color and rep dec on last row.

Work **stripe pattern** with pattern color 2.

Change to main color, rep dec on last row = (65) 69 (73) 73 (77) 77 (81) sts.

Cont ridges until sleeve meas 29 cm, or 11 cm before suitable length with sleeve slightly stretched.

Work 11 cm ribbing back and forth as for front.

Cast off rib-wise.

Work right sleeve in the same manner but beg knitting up sts on the back.

Finishing:

Sew side and sleeve seams inside 1 edge st and in one line.

Neckband:

With small 3 mm circular ndl knit up approx 1 st in every st at neck edge.

P 1 rnd, **at the same time** adjust number of sts to (96) 96 (100) 100 (100) 104 (104).

Work 10 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Fold neck to WS and sew nicely with hidden sts.
