# SWEATER W/CABLES

WORK FROM NECK DOWN W/CABLE PATTERN ON ROUND YOKE / INSTRUCTION: OLAUG BEATE BJELLAND

## SIZES

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

## MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (65) 68 (73) 78 (83) 86 cm

Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) 54 cm, or suitable length

Sleeve length: (25) 29 (31) 35 (38) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

## YARN

SMART (100 % wool, Superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

## ALTERNATIVE YARN

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MERINOULL

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

## YARN REQUIRED

Dk.old rose #4244/Sea-green melange #7252: (5) 6 (7) 7 (8) 9 balls


## SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3 mm and 4 mm  
Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

## TENSION

20 sts St-st with 4 mm ndls = 10 cm

26 sts diagram = 10 cm



## INC FOR ROUND YOKE IS WORKED WITH THE INC IN A MIRROR IMAGE OF EACH OTHER.

Inc to the right after 2 p sts as follows: Pick up yarn between 2 sts after 2 p sts, transfer new st k tbl back to left ndl and k this st.

Inc to the right before 2 p sts as follows: Pick up yarn between 2 sts before 2 p sts, transfer new st k-wise to left ndl and k tbl this new st.

## INFO

Work garment from neck down and inc for round yoke.

Fold neckband to WS and sew with hidden sts.

## YOKE

With 4 mm circular ndl cast on (76) 80 (84) 88 (92) 96 sts.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl and work (5) 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Change to 4 mm circular ndl.

Cont diagram, inc as shown and dec as shown on last rnd of diagram = (190) 200

(210) 220 (230) 240 sts.

Cont St-st over all sts until work meas approx (12) 14 (15) 16 (17) 18 cm from shoulder and straight down.

Divide work as follows:

Work (28) 30 (31) 33 (34) 36 sts (= 1/2back), transfer (38) 40 (42) 44 (46) 48 sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on (8) 8 (10) 12 (14) 14 new underarm sts, work (58) 60 (64) 66 (70) 72 sts (= front), transfer (38) 40 (42) 44 (46) 48 sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on (8) 8 (10) 12 (14) 14 new underarm sts, work (28) 30 (31) 33 (34) 36 sts (= 1/2back).


## BACK AND FRONT

= (130) 136 (146) 156 (166) 172 sts.

Cont St-st with 4 mm ndls until garment meas approx (33) 36 (40) 43 (47) 49 cm straight down from shoulder, or (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) 5 cm before suitable length. Adjust number of sts to (132) 136 (148) 156 (168) 172.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl and work (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) 5 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.



## SLEEVES

Transfer sleeve sts to 4 mm double pointed ndls and at the same time knit up 1 st in each of the new underarm sts = (46) 48 (52) 56 (60) 62 sts on ndls.

Tips: Pick up yarn between the new sts and sleeve sts at each side, and k this new st tog with next st to avoid holes in the knitting.

Insert marker at middle underarm.

Cont St-st in rnds and when sleeve meas 4 cm dec 2 sts at middle underarm as follows: k2tog before marker and k2tog tbl after marker.

Rep dec every (4) 5 (3½) 4 (3½) 4 cm until (36) 40 (40) 44 (44) 48 sts rem.

Cont until sleeve meas (22) 25 (27) 30 (33) 35 cm, or approx (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) 5 cm before full length, dec 4 sts evenly spaced on last rnd = (32) 36 (36) 40 (40) 44 sts.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls and work (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) 5 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.
