FAUNA SWEATER

Work from neck down Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

Sizes:

(XS) S (M) L (XL) XXL (XXXL)

Measurements:

Bust: (105) 109 (114) 119 (124) 128 (133) cm

Length: approx (52) 52 (54) 54 (56) 56 (58) cm

Sleeve length: 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

ALPAKKA SILKE (70 % baby alpaca, 30 % mulberry silk, 50 g = 200 m) TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

Yarn required:

ALPAKKA SILKE

Main color:

Black 1099: (4) 5 (5) 6 (6) 350 (7) balls

Pattern color 1:

Burnt golden brown #2544: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 2:

Dusty pastel green #8521: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 3:

Straw yellow #2113: 1 ball all sizes Pattern color 4:

Petroleum #7572: 1 ball all sizes TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Main color:

Black #1099: (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) balls

Pattern color 1:

Brown sugar #2543: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 2:

Dusty pastel green #8521: 1 ball all sizes

Pattern color 3:

Straw yellow #2113: 1 ball all sizes Pattern color 4:

Dusty olive green #9071: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular 4 mm

Small 3 mm circular for neckband

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

17 sts and 36 rows (= 18 ridges) with double yarn (1 strand ALPAKKA SILKE + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR) and 4 mm ndls = 10x10 cm

1 ridge = k 2 rows

Stripe pattern in ridges

Beg from RS and k 1 row with pattern color.

Work 2 rows from same side in this manner:

*p 1 row with main color,

p 1 row with pattern color,

k 1 row with main color,

k 1 row with pattern color*, rep from

- until 8 stripes with pattern color, end with k 1 row in main color.

INFO:

Garment is worked with double yarn (1 strand ALPAKKA SILKE + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR). Work back and front separately. Work a lower neckline at front and cast off for slanting shoulders.

Sew shoulder seams. Pick up sts for sleeves and work back and forth from top down.

Edge st: k every row

Front:

With main color (double yarn) and 4 mm circular ndl cast on (91) 95 (99) 103 (107) 111 (115) sts and work (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 (10) cm ribbing as follows:

(First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st. Beg from RS and work 9 ridges = 18 rows main color.

Work **stripe pattern** with pattern color 1

Work 9 ridges main color.

Work 9 ridges main color.

Work **stripe pattern** with pattern color ¹

Change to main color and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (7) 7 (7) ridges.

Work meas now approx (46) 46 (48) 48 (50) 50 (52) cm, slightly stretched

Cast off the (13) 13 (13) 15 (15) 15 (17) middle sts for neck and work each side separately.

Right side:

= (39) 41 (43) 44 (46) 48 (49) sts. Cast off at beg of every row from neck side 4 sts once, 2 sts twice, 1 st twice = (29) 31 (33) 34 (36) 38 (39) sts. For slanting shoulder cast off at beg

of every row from sleeve side: 5 sts (4)2(0)0(0)0(0) times, 6 sts (1)3(5)4(2)0(0) times, 7 sts (0)0(0)1(3)5(4) times, 8 sts (0)0(0)0(0)0(1) time, at the same time cast off at neck 1 st 3 times.

Left side:

= (39) 41 (43) 44 (46) 48 (49) sts. Work in the same manner as right side.

Back:

With double yarn in main color and 4 mm circular ndl cast on (91) 95 (99) 103 (107) 111 (115) sts and work in the same manner as front until back meas approx (46) 46 (48) 48 (50) 50 (52) cm, slightly stretched.

Work 5 ridges in main color and end with the same row at cast off for slanting shoulder as the front.

Next row: Cast off the (29) 29 (29) 31 (31) 31 (33) middle sts for neck and work each side separately.

Left side:

= (31) 33 (35) 36 (38) 40 (41) sts For slanting shoulder cast off at beg of every row from sleeve side 5 sts (4)2(0)0(0)0(0)times, 6 sts (1)3(5)4(2)0(0)times, 7 sts (0)0(0)1(3)5(4)8 times, sts (0)0(0)0(0)0(1) time, at the same time cast off for neck 2 sts twice, 1 st once.

Right side:

= (31) 33 (35) 36 (38) 40 (41) sts Work in the same manner as left side.

Sew shoulder seams inside 1 edge st at each side to a nice and even seam. Ensure a not too tight seam.

Left sleeve:

Measure (22) 23 (24) 24 (25) 25 (26) cm from outer point on shoulder seam and straight down with front slightly stretched. Insert marker here and the same on the back.

At RS beg at marker. With main color (double yarn) and 4 mm circular ndl knit up sts as follows:

Knit up 1 st every ridge (= every 2nd row) at front, 1 st at middle of shoulder and 1 st every ridge until



marker on the back. K 1 row and at the same time adjust number of sts to (73) 77 (81) 81 (85) 85 (89).

Work 5 ridges more in main color, at the same time on last row, k2tog inside 1 edge st at each side = 2 sts dec.

Cont **stripe pattern** in pattern color 4. Work 9 ridges in main color and rep dec on last row.

Work **stripe pattern** in pattern color 3.

Work 9 ridges in main color and rep dec on last row.

Work **stripe pattern** in pattern color 2.

Change to main color, and rep dec on first row = (65) 69 (73) 73 (77) 77 (81) sts.

Cont ridges until sleeve meas 29 cm, or 11 cm before suitable length with sleeve slightly stretched.

Work 11 cm ribbing back and forth in the same manner as font.

Cast off rib-wise.

Work right sleeve in the same manner, but begin knitting up sts on the back.

Finishing:

Sew side and sleeve seams inside 1 edge st and in one line.

Neckband:

With small 3 mm circular ndl knit up approx 1 st in every st at neck edge.

P 1 rnd, **at the same time** adjust number of sts to (96) 96 (100) 100 (100) 104 (104).

Work 10 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew nicely with hidden sts.
