SILLE

Sweater w/round yoke
Instruction: Sandnes Garn

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (65) 69 (73) 76 (80) 87 cm

Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) 54 cm, or suitable length

Sleeve length, underarm: (23) 26 (29) 32 (35) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

Yarn:

SMART (100 % wool, superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MANDARIN MEDI, MERINOULL, SPØT

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternate yarn.

Yarn required:

Dusty purple #5052: (4) 5 (5) 6 (8) 9 balls

Putty #1015: (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 balls

Burnt ochre #2544: (2) 2 (2) 3 (3) 3 balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed ndls 3 mm and 3.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

22 sts St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

Sweater is worked from neck down.

Yoke:

With putty and 3 mm circular ndl cast on (84) 88 (92) 96 (100) 104 sts. Join and work (10) 10 (12) 12 (14) 14 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3.5 mm circ ndl and inc (16) 20 (24) 28 (32) 40 sts evenly spaced = (100) 108 (116) 124 (132) 144 sts.

Work **diagram**, and inc as shown = (200) 216 (232) 248 (264) 288 sts.

With dusty purple work (0) 0 (1) 4 (7) 10 rnds St-st.

Divide work for sleeves, back and front as follows:

Work (62) 66 (70) 74 (78) 86 sts [= the back], transfer (38) 42 (46) 50 (54) 58 sts to a spare ndl [= sleeve], cast on 10 underarm sts, work (62) 66 (70) 74 (78) 86 sts [= front], transfer (38) 42 (46) 50 (54) 58 sts to a spare ndl [= sleeve], cast on 10 underarm sts.

Back and front:

= (144) 152 (160) 168 (176) 192 sts.

All further measurements from this rnd.

Cont St-st in rnds until work meas (18) 22 (25) 28 (31) 32 cm, or 4 cm before suitable length.

Change to 3 mm circ ndl and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.

Sleeves:

Transfer sts from spare ndl to 3.5 mm double pointed ndls, and cast on 10 sts at underarm = (48) 52 (56) 60 (64) 68 sts.

Insert marker at center underarm.

Work St-st in rnds and dec 1 st at each side of marker approx every (3) 3 (3) 2,5 (2,5) 2,5 cm until (36) 38 (40) 40 (42) 42 sts rem.

Cont until sleeve meas (19) 22 (25) 28 (31) 36 cm, or 4 cm before suitable length.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.

Work other sleeve the same.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.
