PANTS

Pants worked in St-st Instruction: Sandnes Garn

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Waist: (56) 60 (62) 64 (67) 69 cm Leg length: (34) 42 (50) 58 (65) 70 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

Yarn:

SMART (100 % wool, superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MANDARIN MEDI, MERINOULL, SPØT

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternate yarn

Yarn required:

Green #8215: (4) 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 balls

Notions:

Elastic for waistband

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed ndls 3 mm and 3.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

22 sts St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

Beg at waist:

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (124) 132 (136) 140 (148) 152 sts. Join and work 3 cm ribbing [= facing], p 1 rnd [= folding rnd], 3 cm St-st.

Change to 3.5 mm circ ndl.

Insert marker at center front and center back.

Work extra height at back as follows:: Work until 6 sts passed center back marker, turn, 1 yo, work 12 sts, turn, 1 yo. Cont in this manner, but with (5) 5 (6) 6 (6) 7 sts more at each turning until 5 turnings at each side, and at the same time work yo tog with next st to avoid holes

Cont St-st until work meas (14) 15 (16) 17 (18) 19 cm, from folding rnd at center front

Inc 1 st on alt rnds at each side of center front and center back markers 6 times = (148) 156 (160) 164 (172) 176 sts.

Divide work at center front and center back and work each leg separately.

Leg:

= (74) 78 (80) 82 (86) 88 sts.

Insert marker on first and last st on rnd. Change to 3.5 mm double pointed ndls when necessary.

Cont St.st, and at the same time dec 1 st at each side of marker approx every (2) 2,5 (3) 3,5 (4) 4 cm until (48) 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 sts rem.

Cont until leg meas (30) 38 (46) 54 (61) 66 cm, or 4 cm before suitable length. Work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds

Cast off rib-wise.

Work other leg the same.

Finishing:

Fold facing to WS and sew loosely. Pass elastic through waistband. Sew opening at crotch.

JOHAN HAT

Hat w/pattern and earflaps Instruction Sandnes Garn

Sizes:

(2-4) 6-8 (10-12) yrs

Yarn:

SMART (100 % wool, superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MANDARIN MEDI, MERINOULL, SPØT

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternate yarn.

Yarn required:

Green #8215: (1) 1 (2) balls Lt.sea-green #7721: 1 ball all sizes Lt.grey melange #1032: (1) 1 (2) balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed ndls 3 mm and 3.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

22 sts St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

With green and 3 mm circular ndl cast on (104) 112 (120) sts. Join and work ribbing k1, p1 in rnds as follows:

Work 4 rnds green, 2 rnds

It.sea-green, 2 rnds It.grey melange, cont in green until ribbing meas (6) 8 (10) cm.

Change to 3.5 mm circ ndl.

Cont with diagram in rnds.

After diagram cont in It.grey melange and dec on next rnd as follows:

Work *k6, k2tog*, rep from *-* in the rnd = (91) 98 (105) sts.

Rep dec on alt rnds with 1 st less between each dec on every rnd of dec until (13) 14 (15) sts rem.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

Earflaps (2-4) yrs: (work 2)

With green and 3 mm ndl cast on 19 sts. Work 4 cm ribbing back and forth as follows: [1st row = WS] 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Dec as follows on next row:

1 edge st, sl 1, k1, psso, work ribbing until 3 sts rem, k2tog, 1 edge st. Rep dec on alt rnds until 5 sts rem. Cast off rib-wise.


Finishing:

Fold ribbing double to RS of hat. With all colors make a pompom and

fasten at top of hat. Sew earflaps to hat on inside of

ribbing and approx 7 cm from center back to each side.

With green twist 2 cords and fasten at end of each earflap.

JOHAN MITTENS

Mittens w/pattern Instruction: Sandnes Garn

Sizes:

(2-4) 6-8 (10-12) yrs

Yarn:

SMART (100 % wool, superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MANDARIN MEDI, MERINOULL, SPØT

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternate yarn.

Yarn required:

Green #8215: 1 ball all sizes Lt.sea-green #7721: 1 ball all sizes Lt.grey melange #1032: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Double pointed ndls 3 mm and 3.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

22 sts St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

With green and 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (32) 36 (40) sts. Join and work ribbing k1, p1 in rnds as follows: 5 rnds green, 2 rnds lt.grey melange, 2 rnds lt.sea-green, 5 rnds green Change to 3.5 mm double pointed ndls.

Insert marker at sides with (16) 18 (20) sts for each part.

Work (10) 12 (12) rnds diagram.

Work the first (6) 8 (8) sts with a contrast colored yarn-end, transfer the sts back on left ndl and work sts again but in diagram.

Cont to end of **diagram**, then cont in It.grey.melange and work St-st until mitten meas approx (14) 17 (20) cm. Next rnd, dec as follows:

sl 1, k1, psso, work until 2 sts before next marker, k2tog, rep from *-* once more = 4 sts dec.

Rep dec on alt rnds until 8 sts rem.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well


Thumb:

Pull out contrast yarn and with It.grey melange and 3.5 mm double pointed ndls knit up (6) 8 (8) sts on each part + 1 sts at each side of thumb = (14) 18 (18) sts.

Work St-st until thumb meas approx (4) 5 (6) cm, then (k2tog) in the rnd = (7) 9 (9) sts.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well

Work other mitten the same but work thumb over the last (6) 8 (8) sts.
