CHRISTMAS SWEATER

SINGLE PATTERN NO 104 / RAGLAN SWEATER W/CHRISTMAS PATTERN / INSTRUCTION: ANITA BRATHETLAND

SIZES

(XS-S) M (L-XL) XXL

MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (87) 98 (109) 120 cm
 Length: approx (58) 59 (60) 61 cm
 Sleeve length: 47 cm or suitable length
 All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

YARN

ALPAKKA (100 % alpaca, 50 g = 110 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

PEER GYNT, SMART, DUO, MANDARIN MEDI, MERINOULL

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

YARN REQUIRED

Putty #1015: (6) 7 (8) 9 balls
 Moss green #9573: 1 ball all sizes
 Corn yellow #2015: 1 ball or remnants
 Red #4219: 2 balls all sizes
 Grey beige melange #2650: 1 ball all sizes
 Med.brown melange #2652: 1 ball all sizes
 Dk.brown #4071: 1 ball all sizes
 Black #1099: 1 ball all sizes

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3 mm and 3.5 mm
 Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

22 sts St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

BACK AND FRONT

With putty and 3 mm circular ndl cast on (212) 238 (264) 290 sts. Join and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.
 Change to 3.5 mm circular ndl, k 1 rnd, while dec (20) 22 (24) 26 sts evenly spaced = (192) 216 (240) 264 sts.
 Insert marker at sides with (97) 109 (121) 133 sts (= front) and (95) 107 (119) 131 sts (= back).
 Work **diagram** until garment meas approx 39 cm, and beg at arrow for chosen size.
 Cast off 12 sts at each side for armholes (= 6 sts at each side of markers).
 Put garment aside and work sleeves.

SLEEVES

With putty and 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (46) 48 (50) 52 sts. Join and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.
 Change to 3.5 mm double pointed ndls, k 1

rnd and inc 1 st at middle underarm

Insert marker around first and last st on rnd.

TIPS: Meas length of sleeve on garment to establish start of diagram, for ending with the same pattern rnd as back/front. If necessary cont with putty a few rnds to beg with a full pattern border.

Cont **diagram** until sleeve meas 7 cm, and count from middle of sleeve to establish beg of diagram.

Inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Rep inc every (3) 3 (2½) 2½ cm until (73) 75 (79) 81 sts on rnd.

Cont until sleeve meas 47 cm, or suitable length.

End with the same pattern rnd as back/front, **at the same time** cast off 12 middle underarm sts (= marked sts + 5 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

RAGLAN

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3.5 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (290) 318 (350) 378 sts. Insert marker at each junction. Rnd beg at a junction by sts for the back.

NOTE: Ensure pattern borders to match further.

Cont **diagram** and dec for raglan at each junction as follows: k2tog before markers, and sl 1, k1, pssso after markers = 8 sts dec. Rep dec on alt rnds (18) 20 (22) 24 times = (146) 158 (174) 186 sts.

Transfer the (15) 17 (19) 21 middle front sts to spare ndl for neck.

Cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Cont back and forth, and cast off for neck at beg of every row at each side 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st 5 times, **at the same time** cont raglan dec where possible 7 times more, and a total of (25) 27 (29) 31 times over sts for the back.

NOTE: Cont with putty after diagram is finished.

Leave rem sts on ndl for neckband.

FINISHING

Sew tog at underarms.

NECKBAND

With putty and 3 mm circular ndl work sts at neck and at the same time knit up 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row at neck edge.

K 1 rnd, while adjusting number of sts to (108) 112 (116) 120 (124).

Work 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.
