BUTTERFLY BONNET

Bonnet w/butterfly pattern

Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

Sizes:

(0) 3 (6) 9 mos (1) 2 yrs

Yarn:

ALPAKKA SILKE (70 % baby alpaca, 30 % mulberry silk, 50 g = 200 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Lt.grey melange #1042/Lt.beige #3021: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 mm
Circular 2.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts diagram with 3 mm ndls
= 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

Beg at face edge.

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (75) 79 (87) 91 (99) 103 sts, and work 7 rows ribbing back and forth as follows: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Work **diagram** inside 1 edge st at each side, **while** inc on first row (2) 4 (2) 4 (2) 4 sts evenly spaced = (77) 83 (89) 95 (101) 107 sts.

Cont until work meas approx (9) 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 cm from cast on and end with 6th or 12th row in diagram.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls, join work and cont in rnds and k tog first and last st on rnd = (76) 82 (88) 94 (100) 106 sts.

Cont St-st and k 1 rnd.

Next rnd: *k2, k2tog*, rep from *-*, end with k(0) 2 (0) 2 (0) 2 = (57) 62 (66) 71 (75) 80 sts.

Work 5 rnds St-st with no dec.

Next rnd *k1, k2tog*, rep from *-*, end with k(0) 2 (0) 2 (0) 2 = (38) 42 (44) 48 (50) 54 sts.

Work 5 rnds St-st with no dec.

Next rnd: k2tog in the rnd = (19) 21 (22) 24 (25) 27 sts.

Work 1 rnd St-st with no dec.

Next rnd. k2tog in the rnd, end with k(1) 1 (0) 0 (1) 1 = (10) 11 (11) 12 (13) 14 sts.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

Finishing:

Neckband:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up approx (67) 71 (75) 79 (83) 87 sts at neck edge and work 4 cm ribbing back and forth as at beg of bonnet.

Cast off rib-wise.

Fold neckband and sew loosely with hidden sts on WS.


Cord:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndl cast on 4 sts and work in this manner:

K 1 row, slide sts back to other side of ndl, hold yarn firmly and k the 4 sts. Cont in this manner and knit sts from the same side without turning until cord meas approx. (68) 70 (72) 74 (76) 78 cm.

Cast off.

Pull cord through neckband.

BUTTERFLY SOCKS

Socks w/butterfly pattern

Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6-9 mos (1) 2 yrs

Yarn:

ALPAKKA SILKE (70 % baby alpaca, 30 % mulberry silk, 50 g = 200 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Lt.beige #3021/Lt.grey melange #1042: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Double pointed 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

With 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on a little loosely (30) 34 (36) 38 sts.

Join and work 4 rnds ribbing k1, p1.

K 1 rnd, **while** adjusting number of sts to (30) 36 (36) 42.

Cont **diagram** in rnds until sock meas (7) 8 (9) 10 cm, end with one or more rnds St-st after last pattern border.

Heel:

Transfer (15) 18 (18) 21 sts to spare ndl and work heel over rem (15) 18 (18) 21 sts in this manner: sl first st, hold yarn firmly and k(14) 17 (17) 20 sts, turn, sl first st, hold yarn firmly and p(13) 16 (16) 19 sts, turn.

Cont in this manner by working 1 st less on each row until (7) 8 (8) 7 middle sts on heel rem.

K(7) 8 (8) 7 sts, pick up yarn between 2 sts, transfer st k tbl to left ndl, and work st tog with next st, turn, p(8) 9 (9) 8 sts, pick up yarn between 2 sts,

transfer st k tbl to left ndl, and work st tog with next st, turn.

Cont in this manner and work 1 st more each row until all (15) 18 (18) 21 sts are knitted.

Work (3½) 4½ (5) 5½ cm St-st in rnds over all sts, or approx until 2 cm before suitable length.

Toe dec:


Insert marker at each side with (15) 18 (18) 21 sts between markers.

Dec 2 sts at each side as follows: k2tog before each marker, and sl 1, k1, pssso after each marker = 4 sts dec.

Rep dec on alt rnds until (6) 8 (8) 10 sts rem.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

Work other sock in the same manner.
