SWEATER w/NAVAL COLLAR

Raglan sweater w/collar Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (64) 68 (73) 77 (81) 86

Length: approx (38) 42 (46) 50 (52) 54 cm

Sleeve length: (25) 28 (31) 34 (37) 40 cm. or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, SISU, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

SWEATER AND COLLAR:

Charcoal melange #1055: (4) 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 balls

Black #1099: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

With charcoal melange and 2,5 mm circular ndl cast on (172) 184 (196) 208 (220) 232 sts. Join and work 5 rnds St-st (= facing), p 1 rnd (= folding rnd).

All further measurements from this rnd.

Work 5 rnds St-st.

Change to black and cont St-st in rnds and stripe pattern as follows:

2 rnds black, 2 rnds charcoal melange and 1 rnd black.

Insert marker at each side with (86) 92 (98) 104 (110) 116 sts for each part.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl and charcoal melange. Cont St-st until garment meas approx (24) 29 (30) 34 (35) 36 cm from folding rnd.

Cast off (10) 12 (12) 14 (16) 16 sts at each side for armholes (= (5) 6 (6) 7 (8) 8 sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With charcoal melange and 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (42) 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 sts. Join and work 5 rnds St-st (= facing), p 1 rnd (= folding rnd).

All further measurements from this rnd.

Work 5 rnds St-st.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls, k 1 rnd, **while** inc 6 evenly spaced = (48) 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 sts (inc: pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st).

Work stripe pattern as back/front.

Insert marker around first and last st on rnd = marked sts.

Change to charcoal melange and cont St-st, at the same time inc 1 st at each side of markers.

Rep inc every 3 cm until (64) 68 (72) 76 (80) 84 sts.

Cont until sleeve meas approx (25) 28 (31) 34 (37) 40 cm from folding rnd, or suitable length.

Cast off (10) 12 (12) 14 (16) 16 middle underarm sts.

Put aside and work other sleeve the same

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (260) 272 (292) 304 (316) 336 sts.

Insert marker at each junction.

Rnd beg at right side on the back.

Cont St-st, at the same time dec for raglan on second rnd at each marker as follows:

Work until 2 sts before marker, sl 1, k1, psso, k2tog = 8 sts dec.

Rep dec on alt rnds (16) 17 (19) 20 (21) 23 times = (132) 136 (140) 144 (148) 152 sts.

Cast off the (12) 14 (14) 16 (16) 18 middle front sts for neck, work to end of rnd, cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Dec for raglan on RS rows.

Cont back and forth, cont dec for raglan 6 times more where this is possible, at the same time cast off at neck at beg of every row at each side 3 sts once, 2 sts twice, 1 st 3 times. Cast off rem sts.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings

Neckband:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndls knit up 1 st every st/row at neck edge, k 1 rnd, **while** adjusting number of sts to (92) 100 (100) 104 (112) 116.

Work *p 1 rnd, k 1 rnd*, rep *-* once more, p 1 rnd = 3 ridges. Cast off loosely k-wise

NAVAL COLLAR

Sizes

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

GSR = German Short Rows:

After each turning always sl first st p-wise (as working p1), lead yarn over right ndl, pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on ndl.

The 2 loops count as 1 stitch.

When working rows with loops, work loops tog to 1 stitch.

<u>Inc to the right:</u> Pick up yarn between 2 sts before marked st, transfer new st k tbl to left ndl, and k the new st.

Inc to the left: Pick up yarn between 2 sts after marked st, transfer new st k-wise to left ndl, and k tbl the new st.

1 ridge worked in rnd: k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd

Work collar from neck down and inc for raglan.

With charcoal melange and 2,5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (92) 100 (100) 104 (112) 116 sts. Join and work 3 ridges in rnds.



Work turnings with **GSR** (as explained) for a deeper neckline at front as follows: k(14) 16 (16) 17 (19) 20 sts, turn, p(28) 32 (32) 34 (38) 40 sts, turn. Cont St-st back and forth and turn in the same manner, but turn 4 sts <u>after</u> previous turning until 3 times at each side.

K 1 rnd over all sts.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Cont St-st and insert markers for raglan inc as follows:

Work (16) 17 (17) 18 (19) 20 sts (= $\frac{1}{2}$ back), work 1 st and insert marker around this st, work (12) 14 (14) 14 (16) 16 sts (= over shoulder), work 1 st and insert marker around this st, work (32) 34 (34) 36 (38) 40 sts (= front), work 1 st and insert marker around this st, work (12) 14 (14) 14 (16) 16 sts (= over shoulder), work 1 st and insert marker around this st. Rnd beg here with the (32) 34 (34) 36 (38) 40 sts for the back.

Inc for raglan at each side of marked sts as explained = 8 sts inc.

Rep inc for raglan on alt rnds a total of (9) 11 (11) 12 (14) 15 times = (164) 188 (188) 200 (224) 236 sts.

Work 1 rnd with black.

Rep inc on alt rnds 5 times more, at the same time work stripe pattern as follows: 2 rnds charcoal melange 2 rnds black.

Change to charcoal melange and *k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd*, rep *-* 3 times = 3 ridges.

After all inc (204) 228 (228) 240 (264) 276 sts on rnd.

Cast off loosely k-wise.
